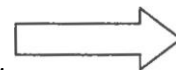

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

Dear Students and Parents/Guardians:

To be considered for admission to Cristo Rey Baton Rouge Franciscan High School, students must submit all of the documents listed below. Once all documents have been received, and if the Admissions Committee needs additional information, the student and parent/guardian will be contacted to schedule an interview. **A complete admission file is required in order to be reviewed by the Admissions Committee. It is the parent/guardian's responsibility to check with the Admissions Office to confirm that your child's file is complete.**

1. Submit the following items directly to the Cristo Rey Admissions Office: (hand deliver, mail, fax or scan/email to address on reverse side)

- Completed Application for Admission along with the following documents:
- Most recent W-2 of each adult in household
- Most recent Income Tax Return (1040 or 1040A) of each adult in household. If no taxes filed, submit Employment Letter and any other proof of income.
** If applicable, copy of documentation for the following forms of income: Social Security Income (SSI), Welfare/TANF, Child Support, Food Stamps, Worker's Compensation, Pension Income, Disability Income Subsidy, Student Loans or Grants received, Foster Care, Housing, Assistance for Parent's or Guardian's education*
- Completed TADS Financial Aid Application Form
- Appropriate government document to confirm age (i.e., birth certificate, passport, etc.)
- Social Security Card
- Student Photo

**The above items are necessary to prequalify your student to continue the admissions process.*
